**SUBJECT:** Policy and Program Memorandum 130: *School Board Programs for Students Who Have Received a Full Expulsion*

The purpose of this memo is to inform you that Policy/Program Memorandum 130 has been extended to June 30, 2007. The attached copy contains no significant changes from the PPM 130 originally issued in September 2001.

PPM 130 provides direction to school boards concerning policies related to the provision of programs, courses and services for students who have received a full expulsion and wish to return to a publicly funded school. This PPM applies to school boards that are not involved in a Strict Discipline pilot project. A special support fund is available to facilitate the provision of Strict Discipline Programming for individual students on a case-by-case basis.

The PPM takes effect on September 1, 2006 and has been posted on the ministry website at [www.edu.gov.on.ca](http://www.edu.gov.on.ca).
