On January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008 the Ministry issued a call for applications to offer SHSMs in 2008-09. - 3. experiential learning through job shadowing, work experience, and job twinning,
- 4. 'reach ahead' opportunities which allow students to experience learning in their intended postsecondary destination,
- 5. development of Essential Skills and work habits required in the sector, and use of the Ontario Skills Passport (OSP) for purposes of documentation.

- 2. ongoing implementation requirements for schools,
- 3. start up requirements for new SHSM sector(s) in a school, and
- 4. a board partnership credit.

Additional clarification of these factors will be provided in the transfer agreement. Your board will be required to update student enrolment in your program(s) in the 2008-09 reports. Adjustments to funding for student costs will be made to transfer payments throughout the year as actual student SHSM enrolment is reported.
