**SUBJECT:** **Update re: 2011 Child Care Funding Allocation Memo**

We are writing to provide you with an update on the 2011 Child Care Funding Allocation Memo you received on December 23, 2010. At that time you were advised that the remainder of your 2010/11 stabilization and/or extended day fee subsidies allocation would be forthcoming. We want to assure you that we are continuing to work closely with the Ministry of Children and Youth Services to confirm the amounts that you would have received up to December 31, 2010 and will begin flowing to you any remaining funds in March/April.

In the meantime we are pleased to provide you with your annualized 2011 allocation for stabilization and extended day fee subsidies as reflected in the enclosed table. Please note that these amounts have been based on your 2010 allocation and do not include any new additional funds that may be made available in 2011. Notification regarding any changes to year two stabilization and extended day fee subsidy funding will be provided in the near future. In addition and consistent with last year, minor capital stabilization funding has also not been included in these amounts as these funds will be flowed to you separately according to the stabilization guidelines.

Last, we recognize that there were some discrepancies identified in regards to your 2011 child care funding allocation, specifically with respect to funding line A663 – Early Learning and Child Development Fee Subsidies. We are working quickly to restore this funding line to its appropriate level and resolve any other issues that were brought to our attention.

Once these aforementioned adjustments have been made, we will be providing you with a table reflecting your updated 2011 child care funding allocation.
