Dear Colleagues,

Further to the Centre Jules-Léger (CJL) Ministerial announcement on October 12, I am writing to provide you with an update on the transfer of governance of CJL to the 12 French-language school boards (FLSBs) in the province.

This afternoon, Ontario introduced legislation that, if passed, would:

- Transfer governance of CJL governance from the Ministry of Education to a new consortium of the 12 FLSBs working together.
- Establish a structure that is governed by and for Francophones.
- Give the CJL Consortium the same duties and powers of a French-language school board, as outlined in the Education Act (except with some provisions specific to CJL's unique mandate).

The proposed changes respond to what the ministry heard during the public consultations of early 2016 and to recommendations made in 2015 by the French Language Services Commissioner which recommended that CJL should be governed "by and for Francophones".

The current mandate of Centre Jules-Léger would not change and the proposed legislation would not affect programs and services offered by English-language provincial and demonstration schools.

Enclosed you will find additional information on the proposed legislation which, I hope, will provide answers to any questions that you may have. Throughout this process, we will continue to work with families, students and staff to ensure that the proposed transfer of governance of CJL is as seamless as possible.
